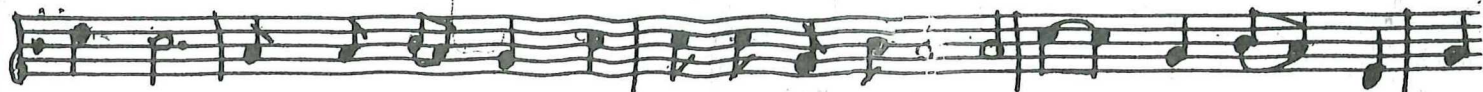




There were three loving brothers, in merry Scotland, and three loving brothers
